Call To Order

The meeting was called to order at 4:04 PM by Commissioner Messbauer.

Oath Administration:

Chairperson Nomination

Commissioner Messbauer asked for nominations for the position of Chairman of the Board for 2023. Commissioner Bowers nominated Commissioner Stoerger with a second to the nomination being offered by Commissioner Messbauer. The Board voted unanimously to re-elect Commissioner Stoerger as Chairman.

Vice Chairperson Nomination:

Commissioner Messbauer asked for nominations for the position of Vice Chairman of the Board for 2023. Commissioner Messbauer nominated Commissioner Bowers with a second to the nomination offered by Commissioner Stoerger. The Board voted unanimously to elect Commissioner Bowers as Vice Chairman.

District Treasurer Friscano submitted the Annual Financial Report for 2022. A copy is attached with the minutes. Also, his plan to get our Unreserved / Unappropriated fund back to less than 24% is to use the overage to lower the 2024 tax assessment. {See Attachment - F}

Motion by Commissioner Bowers, 2nd. Commissioner Stoerger to accept the treasurer’s plan to get our Unreserved/Unappropriated fund back to 24%. Unanimously approved.

Reaffirmation of the Surety Bond

A motion to Reaffirm the Surety Bond of \$1,000,000.00 for the Treasurer, Administrator/ Deputy Treasurer, and Chief due for renewal, March 1, 2023 (Copy to be sent to the Town Clerk) (District Administrator will get it to the Clerk) by Commissioner Bowers, 2nd. Commissioner Stoerger. Unanimously approved.

Adopt the 2023 Organizational Chart for the District

Designate the Official District Bank:

Motion to designate all commercial banks that meet the requirements of municipal collateral, with branch offices located within our district as the official depositories for the district. Canandaigua National Bank presently meets these requirements and is our Official Bank. Commissioner Stoerger, 2nd. Commissioner Messbauer. Unanimously approved.

Review of our District Policies:

Both the Financial Management and Procurement policies are being revised and will be presented to the board for approval when completed.

Board Motion: To empower the Chairman or Vice Chairman, in his absence, to sign any contracts on behalf of the district whenever such contracts are approved by at least three members of the Board at a meeting of the Board during the year by Commissioner Bowers, 2nd. Commissioner Messbauer. Unanimously approved.

The Commission will meet on the Third Tuesday of the month at 18:30 hrs at Ridge Road District Headquarters 1299 Long Pond Road except on the following dates: Tuesday March 14th 18:30 hrs, Monday May 15th 18:30, and Tuesday December 12th at 18:30 hrs. reserved for the commission election. **RESOLUTION

RESOLVED that in case any of the members appointed herein are unable or refuse to assume or perform the duties required of them, this Board of Fire Commissioners will use the alternate who is a resident elector; and be it further.

RESOLVED that, if clerical help is deemed necessary, upon request of the Chairman of the Fire District Board of Elections, the Board of Fire Commissioners will consider the appointment of such clerical persons.
